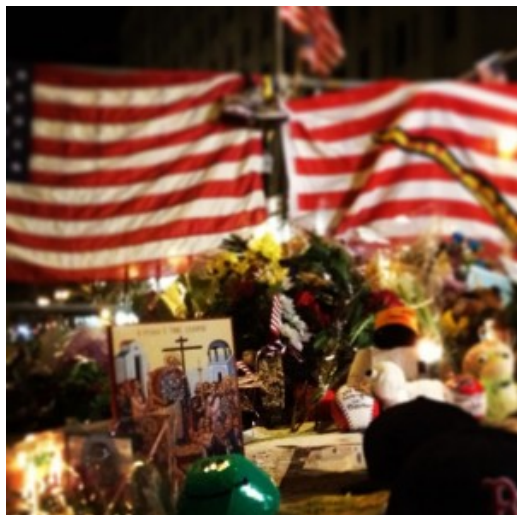




U.S. Secretary of State thanks Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk for words of sympathy and support following terrorist attacks in Boston
